Reading/Language Arts:

- Parents should read 20 minutes daily with their child. Ask questions related to the story. Use the 5 W's. (Who, What, Where, When, Why)
- Practice writing first and last name.
- Recite and recognize letters of the alphabet, capital/lowercase Aa.
- Attempt letter sound recognition
- Practice coloring skills.
- Draw a picture and try to write a simple sentence.
- Obtain a library card from your local public library

Mathematics:

- Count to 50.
- Recognize numbers to 20.
- Recognize shapes (square, triangle, rectangle, circle, rhombus and octagon.)
- Recognize number words to ten and color words.

Social Studies:

- Read The Night Before Kindergarten By: Natasha Wing
- Cooperation: helping around the house, parents give daily chores to students (pick up room, toys, help set the table for dinner, etc.)
- Taking turns: playing games, reading books with siblings, cousins, friends or neighbors.
- Hygiene/Routines: Please make sure students can wash hands and use bathroom facilities independently. Please make sure your child can tie his or her shoes.
